He served as president of St. Petersburg Theological Seminary and Yeshiva, then established and staffed a philosophy department at Forman Christian College, Lahore, Pakistan - all the while assisting smaller churches in each of these places to regain their momentum and develop the richness of their fellowship in our Christ.
